We at Open Arms want you to feel at home while participating in this innovative program, designed to provide you a safe and supportive place to rest, recover your health, and begin to find permanent solutions to your specific needs. We are a 12 bed confidential site offering housing to men and women.

The Open Arms program is dedicated to providing a nurturing environment while meeting the emergency housing need of homeless persons diagnosed as ✕HIV positive and those living with AIDS✕. Open Arms offers participants 90-days of temporary housing, an environment for healing, three meals a day, group and individual counseling, and case management for healthcare, housing and social service needs.

In order to receive the services of the Open Arms program an individual must attend Orientation at Breaking Barriers and be formally admitted.
